

SOFT REOPENING | SAFETY PLAN

ACTION	PURPOSE & EXPLANATION
Closing the lobby	<p><u>OUR LOBBY</u> will be <u>closed</u> to anyone that is not a dancer.</p> <p>Parents dropping off any dancers ages 3-5 years old will be kindly asked to bring their dancer to the door/pick up from door. No waiting in the lobby while they are in class.</p> <p>We will establish a "drop off zone" in front of our studio doors and will have a staff member/designated volunteer on duty to ensure our younger dancers are safely escorted into the studio.</p>
Staggered class start times	We will modify our schedule so that classes do not go in/let out at the same time to avoid traffic in the hallways.
Closing the smoothie bar	Our smoothie bar will remain closed until further notice to avoid extra loitering in the lobby.
Smaller class sizes	We will be reducing our class sizes depending on which studio the class is in. Exact numbers are still to be determined.
Extra sanitisation practices	<p>We will be sanitizing all bars, mats, balls & other props before and after each use.</p> <p>The studios will be cleaned daily (as always) but we will be taking extra precautions to ensure that every surface is properly sanitized.</p> <p>Our front desk staff will ensure that doorknobs and high traffic surfaces are sanitized at every class turnover.</p>
Floor markings to aid in social distancing	We will be marking the floor with tape to help our dancers navigate a safe distance between each other.
Modified Dress Code	We will be modifying our dress code to lessen the time spent in the dressing room, only shoes will need to be changed. This means that you will not be required to wear your ballet leotard and tights until further notice. We expect all dancers to wear leggings, shorts, sports bras, form fitting tops etc. Nothing baggy/loose will be accepted.
Encourage the reduction of bathroom usage	We ask that bathroom breaks are limited and if possible, for our dancers to use the bathroom before coming to the studio.
Hand sanitizing before and after class	We ask that all dancers sanitize/wash hands before and after class. We will be installing two touchless hand sanitizer stations in the studio. One at the lobby entrance and another at the hallway entrance.

NO SYMPTOM POLICY	If your dancer or anyone in your home is experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms including fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat and/or painful swallowing we ask that you stay home until no symptoms are present for a minimum of 14 days.
Studio "WATER"	We will use studio Water (biggest studio) as frequently as possible with the large bay door open to aid in keeping fresh air flow.
Water Bottles	We will be closing our water fountain (for now) and ask that all dancers bring ample amounts of water to the studio. We also ask that dancers do NOT share any water bottles, silverware, food etc.
ENTRANCE/EXIT	We are looking at utilizing multiple entry/exit ways to aid in flow of traffic. We will communicate this on a case to case scenario as we <i>may</i> ask you to drop off/pick up from the back of the studio.

Masks and gloves will be optional.
